### **TEACHER OF ENGLISH**

### **TEACHER OF PSYCHOLOGY and ICT**

The successful candidate must have a minimum of two to three years' current experience teaching the required Psychology curriculum at A level and must have a degree in Psychology. The successful candidate will also be expected to teach the required ICT curriculum and must have a degree in ICT or Computer Science. A minimum of two to three years' current experience teaching ICT at Key Stages 3 and 4, as well as experience teaching IT at Key Stage 5 (A Level). In addition, the successful applicant must have an internationally recognized teaching qualification, such as a Postgraduate Certificate in Education or a Bachelor of Education in the relevant subject areas.

In addition to the requirements listed for the positions above each successful candidate must be:

- An excellent classroom practitioner with creative and innovative ideas, committed to achieving high academic standards and passionate about creating a stimulating and student-centered learning environment
- Enthusiastic and knowledgeable about the English National Curriculum
- Willing to be involved in a wide range of school-related activities
- Fully proficient in using Management Information Systems, such as SIMS and Microsoft Office products, especially MS Word and Excel
