TEACHER OF SCIENCE

The successful candidate must have a degree in science or a specific Science discipline (Biology, Chemistry or Physics). A PGCE/PGDE in either science or a specific science discipline or a Bachelor of Education in Science. A minimum of three to five years' current experience teaching the core Science subjects at Key Stage 3, 4 and 5 (A Level). Preference will be given to applicants who possess the ability to teach more than one science discipline at the GCSE level. Experience teaching Marine Science at GCSE and A level is a distinct advantage.

TEACHER OF ICT AND COMPUTER SCIENCE

The successful candidate must have a degree in ICT or Computer Science and an internationally recognized teaching qualification, such as a Postgraduate Certificate in Education or a Bachelor of Education. A minimum of three to five years' current experience teaching both ICT and Computer Science at Key Stages 3 and 4, as well as experience teaching Computer Science at Key Stage 5 (A Level).

TEACHER OF HISTORY AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

The successful candidate must have a degree in History or Religious Education and an internationally recognized teaching qualification, such as a Postgraduate Certificate in Education or a Bachelor of Education. A minimum of three to five years' current experience teaching History to A-level and teaching Religious Education to GCSE.

In addition to the requirements listed for the positions above each successful candidate must be:

- An excellent classroom practitioner with creative and innovative ideas, committed to achieving high academic standards and passionate about creating a stimulating and student-centered learning environment
- Enthusiastic and knowledgeable about the English National Curriculum
- Experienced and skilled in providing differentiated learning opportunities to support, meet and challenge the needs of all learners is essential
- Willing to be involved in a wide range of school-related activities
- Fully proficient in using Management Information Systems, such as SIMS and Microsoft Office products, especially MS Word and Excel
