- Possess science technician qualifications and be confident with A Level Biology and Chemistry practicals.
- Have safety certifications in chemical handling, electrical safety and first-aid.

In addition to the requirements listed for the position above, the successful candidate must be:

- Knowledgeable in taking responsibility for ordering supplies and ensuring labs are fully resourced.
- Knowledgeable in overseeing the Health & Safety of the department.
- IT literate. VLE and SIMS experience is an advantage.
- Practised in engaging with students in lessons and extracurricular activities to support learning in science.
- Willing to be involved in a wide range of school-related activities, laboratory prep and clean up.
- Committed to being fully part of a high functioning team and a positive addition to staff.
- Expected to fully adhere to and support the Christian ethos of the school.
